Carl Greves asked what was the total cost of the materials. Jeremy Frable explained that we bid it out for more or less. We might need more of a certain material or less of a certain material. So cost is technically an estimate. Jimmy Akins motioned to approve and accept the 2024 Materials Bid. Glenn Hummel seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion was carried. 2-0 Attorney Datte asked Jeremy Frable about the material that did not have a bid on it. Jeremy Frable said he believes he could go to an outside source to get the stone because we did not have any other bidders.

**B. Line Painting Quotes**

Glenn Hummel said we reached out to three different companies for a quote on line painting. The three companies were DE Gemmill, RoadSafe Traffic Systems, Inc. and Guidemark, Inc. Guidemark did not submit a quote. RoadSafe Traffic Systems, Inc. priced out the Line Painting at \$17,366.88 this would be for 4" Yellow waterborne payment markings for 60,984 LF & 4" Double Yellow waterborne payment markings for 41,870 LF. DE Gemmill's price quote was \$14,670.82 for the 60,984 LF 4" single line yellow painted line with waterborne markings and beads and 41,870 LF 4" Double yellow line with waterborne markings paint and beads. Glenn Hummel said there is almost a \$3K difference. Jimmy Akins made a motion to accept the bid from DE Gemmill. Glenn Hummel seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion was carried. 2-0
